

**Ali Pajaziti**, Ph.D. (1972), sociologist, thinker & researcher, translator from Skopje (Macedonia), lecturer in SEE University on sociology, ethics and anthropology, President of Balkan Sociological Forum, editor of humanities publications at Logos-A Publishers, member of the Council of Max van der Stoel Institute.

Author of several books in the field: *Sociological Essays* (Logos-A, 2003), *University Youth and Religion* (Logos-A, 2003), *In Veritas-Sociological Tractatus* (Logos-A, 2005), *Public Ethics* (trans. & ed., Logos-A, 2005), *Information Technologies and Ethics* (SEEU, 2008), *Culture and Quality of Life: The Case of Macedonia* (Logos-A, 2011), *Culturological Studies: Education, Politics, Identity* (Dauti Foundation & ISPN, 2012), Ali Pajaziti et.al., *Quality of life in global crisis era: The reality of Macedonia's Albanians* (ISPN, 2013), *Socio-Political Insights: Towards Debalkanization*, Lambert Academic Publishing, 2013). He is author of the first Albanian sociological dictionary (*Dictionary of Sociology*, 832 pages, 2009). McGuire, *Religion: The social Context*, Ahmet Davutoğlu, *Self-perceptions of Civilizations*, Burcu A. Ellis, *Shadow Identities*, Tariq Ramadan, *To be a European Muslim* etc.).

He participated in several conferences and symposiums throughout the Europe (University of Wien, Forli/Bologna, Novi Sad, Poitiers, Warsaw, Bursa, Craiova, Rotterdam) and published articles in national and international journals (*SEER*, *Contemporary Issues*, *Social Studies*, *SEEU Review*, *Revista di Științe Politice*, *Procedia*, *Political Thought*). He is one of three authors of EACME Winner paper (2008), High Performance Award at SEEU (2013) and President of Balkan Sociological Forum (2014).
